We evaluate volunteers' professional credentials, and provide training that is appropriate to their role.

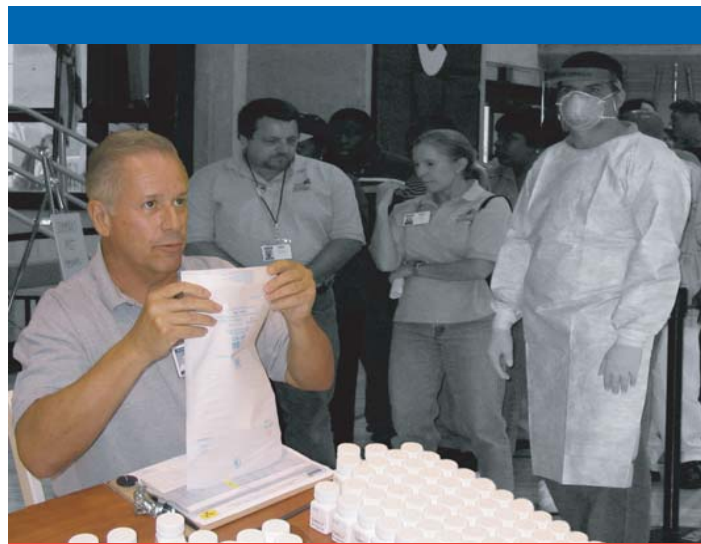
Some of the functions volunteers will be asked to fulfill are:

Ready to respond

Yes, when a large-scale medical or public health emergency occurs, such as a natural disaster, a bioterrorism attack or even an influenza pandemic, we will be there.

The Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) is a community-based group of medical and non-medical volunteers that are pre-trained, prepared and ready to respond to emergencies.

MRC volunteers are sponsored throughout the country by the Office of the U.S. Surgeon General and supported in Florida by the Florida Department of Health.

MRC includes medical volunteers such as physicians, nurses, pharmacists, dentists, epidemiologist, and non-medical volunteers that provide valuable administrative and support services.

MRC volunteers supplement existing local emergency and public health resources during times of community need.
